Capability

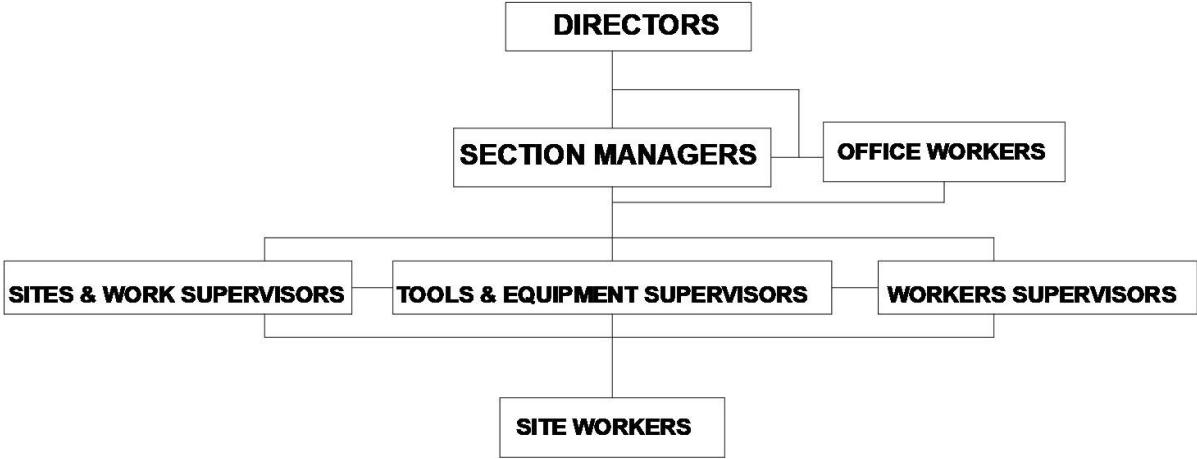
The company is capable of handling construction works of over Ksh.500M (5M\$) owing to its able personnel and equipment. This
